

David Catchpole is a Ph.D. student in Historical Musicology at New York University and a member of the board of the Dvořák American Heritage Association.

Before joining NYU, David received a Master of Music degree from Texas State University with a thesis entitled "Victor Kolar (1888-1957): A Czech Musician in Early Twentieth-Century America." While at Texas State, David received the 2017-2018 Outstanding Graduate Student Award from the College of Fine Arts and Communications. His research has been supported by a travel subvention from the American Musicological Society.

He has written program notes for the BBC Proms, Austin Cantorum, and presented and lectured across the United States and internationally on twentieth-century opera, Habsburg culture and music around the fin-de-siècle, and Czech-American musical culture in the early twentieth century.
